This position is a casual employment position initially with potential for it to become a part-time role in the future. Rosters are supplied fortnightly.

Team Leader opportunities are also available for suitable Play Coordinators as business needs arise.

The successful Play Coordinator will be required to;

- Coordinate play sessions from beginning to end
- Assist children, parents and carers throughout play sessions
- Present the play session introduction
- Complete administrative tasks to assist with individual/group bookings
- Positively communicate with customers
- Complete routine play stall cleaning and re-set
